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Réamhrá ón bPríomhfheidhmeannach agus ón gCathaoirleach

Foreword by Chief Executive and Cathaoirleach

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TÁ RÍMÉAD AR CHOMHAIRLE contae an Longfoirt forbairt an chéad phlean cúig bliana Chultúir & Chruthaitheachta don Chontae a stiúradh. Tá cultúr ag croílár fhéiniúlacht an Longfoirt agus ag croílár chaighdeán na beatha sa Longfort, agus tá ról tábhachtach aige maidir le contae bríomhar a chruthú ina bhfeadhadh daoine cónaí, oibriú agus gnó a dhéanamh. Chomh maith leis sin, is cultúr a mheallann turasóirí anseo, go háirithe ár nDiaspóra a thagann ar ais go minic chun ceangal a chothú lena n-áit dúchais. Ar go leor bealaí, mar a leagtar amach inár bPlean Corparáideach, is é an Longfort “An Áit le Bheith”: tá tírdhreach álainn aige, chomh maith le spiorad pobail iontach agus saol cultúrtha inar féidir le cruthaitheacht fás agus a bheith faoi bhláth.

Is é rialtas áitiúil príomhuirlis na rannpháirtíochta cultúr agus pobail. Mar údarás áitiúil, a infheistíonn a lán in infreastruchtúr agus soláthar cultúr agus oidhreachta, tá ríméad ar Chomhairle Contae an Longfoirt oibriú le Éire Ildánach chun an straitéis cúig bliana seo a chur in iúl, straitéis a bhfuil sé mar aidhm aici cultúr agus cruthaitheacht a chur ag croílár ár saoil. Aithníonn rialtas áitiúil agus náisiúnta araon na tairbhí sochaíocha a bhaineann le cultúr agus cruthaitheacht agus an ról atá ag cultúr maidir le pobail inbhuanaithe, chomhghreamaitheacha agus tiomanta a thógáil. Tá Comhairle Contae an Longfoirt thar a bheith bródúil as an obair a dhéanaimid chun oidhreacht, leabharlanna, na healaíona agus cruthaitheacht a chur chun cinn, agus tugann an tionscnamh seo deis déiunn ár n-obair a ailíniú le beartas náisiúnta agus leis na cúig cholún a bhfuil túis áite acu in Éire Ildánach.

LONGFORD COUNTY COUNCIL IS delighted to lead in the development of the county's first five year Culture & Creativity Plan. Culture is at the heart of Longford's identity and quality of life, and is central to making it a vibrant county to live, work and do business in. It is also what makes the county an attractive destination for visitors and, in particular our Diaspora who regularly return to connect with their roots. In many ways, Longford, as outlined in our Corporate Plan is “The Place To Be” with the perfect combination of an unspoiled pastoral landscape, partnered with a great community spirit and thriving cultural scene, in which creativity can grow and thrive.

Inár nÚdarás Áitiúil, trasna a lán ranna agus seirbhísí cosúil le Fiontar, Pleanáil, Leabharlanna, Oidhreacht, Pobal agus na hEalaíona, tá dáimh ag ár bhfoireann le fíos agus spiorad an chláir Éire Ildánach. Léiríonn roinnt tionscnamh go bhfuilimid tiomanta do thodhchaí chultúrtha an Longfoirt. Áiritear leis na tionscnaimh seo céad Chruinniú an Longfoirt, a d'éisigh thar barr leis, conairí cosúil le Conair Litríochta an Longfoirt agus Conair Reibiliúnach an Longfoirt, an Leabharlann Phobail nua i Meathas Troim, an fhobairt atá beartaithe chun Mol Cruthaitheachta agus Nuálaíochta do Sholáthróirí a thógáil, an fhís atá ann do Loch Rí agus Réigiún na Sionainne Láir, agus an chéad fhéile gearrscannáin sa chontae. An bhliain seo, tá rún againn ceiliúradh a dhéanamh ar an gcéad Chruinniú do dhaoine óga agus béim mhór a leagan ar dheis a thabhairt dár bpáistí agus daoine óga páirt a ghlagadh i gcineálacha difriúla gníomhaíochta cruthaitheachta, ó chódúchán go dtí scríbhneoireacht chruthaitheach, ceol agus damhsa. Tá sé beartaithe againn chomh maith ceiliúradh a dhéanamh ar ócайдí cosúil le breith Maria Edgeworth, bean atá ar dhuine de na scríbhneoirí is fearr a bhí againn sa Longfort, agus ar dheireadh an Chéad Chogaidh Dhomhanda agus ar fhír agus mná cróga an Longfoirt a ghlag páirt sa chogadh.

Ceapaimid go bhfuilimid réidh anois leas a bhaint as na deiseanna a chrutháonn Éire Ildánach agus d'éisigh go maith linn go dtí seo agus muid ag comhoibriú leis an bpobal cruthaitheach sa chontae. Tarraingeoidh Center Parcs Longford Forest agus tionscadail eile turasóireachta cultúr a lán cuairteoirí chuig ár gcontae agus soláthróidh siad deis iontach na gneithe is fearr ár gcultúir agus cruthaitheachta a chur in iúl do phobail áitiúla, náisiúnta agus idirnáisiúnta.

In our Local Authority, across many departments and services Enterprise, Planning, Libraries, Heritage, Community and Arts, our staff connect to the vision and spirit of Creative Ireland. Initiatives such as the first Longford Cruinniú, which was a huge success in this county, trails such as the Longford Literary Trail, the Longford Rebel Trail, the new Edgeworthstown Community Library, the planned development of the Providers Creative and Innovation Hub, the vision for Lough Ree and Mid Shannon region and the first short film festival in the county, clearly demonstrate our commitment to the cultural future of Longford. This year we intend to celebrate our first young people's Cruinniú and to put a strong focus on giving our children and young people an opportunity to engage with different forms of creative activity from coding to creative writing, music and dance. We also plan to celebrate events such as the birth of one of Longford's greatest writers Maria Edgeworth and to commemorate the ending of the First World War and the many brave Longford men and women who took part in it.

We feel that we are now well placed to fully engage with the opportunities created through Creative Ireland and already have a good track record of collaborating successfully with our creative community in the county. Center Parcs Longford Forest and other exciting cultural tourism oriented projects will bring many visitors to our county and provide a great opportunity to showcase the best of our culture and creativity to a local, national and international audience.

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Cultúr agus Cruthaitheacht sa Longfort

Culture and Creativity in Longford

IS É AN LONGFORT an ceathrú contae is lú sa tír a bhfuil daonra 43,000 aige (Daonáireamh 2016). Tá daonra an Longfoirt óg agus tá sé ag fás: tá 12,528 leanbh agus duine óg ina gcónaí sa chontae. Anuas air sin, tá ceann de na rátaí breithe is airde sa tír ag an Longfort, chomh maith leis an céadán is mó leanai ón lucht siúil agus leanai de bhunadh tíortha eile sa tír.

Tá láidreacht chultúr Chontae an Longfoirt ag croílár fhéiniúlacht an chontae. Is cuid dár gcultúr iad teanga, áit, oidhreacht (nádúrtha, cultúrtha agus tóghtha), traidisiúin, ealaín, spórt, pobal, tíreolaíocht, gnásanna sóisialta, luachanna, dearadh, stair, tirdhreach, bithéagsúlacht, scannánaíocht, grianghrafadóireacht, ceol, litríocht, damhsa, scéalaíocht, na tionscail chruthaitheacha agus ilchineálacht chultúrtha. Tugann flúirse agus éagsúlacht an chultúir agus na hoidhreachta sa Longfort féiniúlacht agus nádúr ar leith don chontae. Spreagtar ár gcultúr agus cruthaitheacht ag oidhreacht chultúrtha agus tirdhreach an chontae, agus tá cultúr agus cruthaitheacht le feiceáil ann chomh maith. Ar an taobh eile den scéal, tá tionchar ag ár gcultúr agus tirdhreach ar fhéiniúlacht, braistint áite agus nádúr an chontae.

Tá an Longfort an-bhródúil as a chultúr. San am a caitheadh, bhí cónaí ar scríbhneoirí cosúil le Oliver Goldsmith, Maria Edgeworth, John Keegan ‘Leo’ Casey, Padraic Colum and more recently Belinda McKeon, John Connell, Dani Gill among many others. Longford also maintains a very strong drama tradition, both professional and amateur. It is also the location of one of Europe’s most influential and prestigious dance schools – Shawbrook, which has produced dancers and choreographers of international renown, including Marguerite Donlon, a native of Longford town. Award-winning choreographer, Michael Keegan-Dolan and his dance company, Teac Damsa (formerly the Fabulous Beast Dance Company), has drawn great inspiration for his work from his Longford roots.

LONGFORD IS THE fourth-smallest county in the country, with a population of 43,000, (Census 2016). It has a young and growing population with a total of 12,528 children and young people living in the county. In addition, it has one of the highest birth rates, as well as the highest proportion of Traveller and non-national children in the country.

Central to the identity of County Longford is the strength of its culture, comprising: language, place, heritage (natural, cultural and built), traditions, art, sport, community, geography, social customs, values, design, history, landscape, biodiversity, film, photography, music, literature, dance, story, creative industries and cultural diversity. It is this wealth and diversity of culture and heritage in Longford that gives the county its unique identity and character. Our culture and creativity is inspired by, and reflected in, the cultural heritage and landscape of the county. Conversely, our culture and landscape helps to define our county's identity, sense of place and character. Longford is very proud of its culture. In the past it was home to writers such as Oliver Goldsmith, Maria Edgeworth, John Keegan ‘Leo’ Casey, Padraic Colum and more recently Belinda McKeon, John Connell, Dani Gill among many others. Longford also maintains a very strong drama tradition, both professional and amateur. Tá ceol i gcroílár fhéiniúlacht chultúrtha Chontae an Longfoirt, ó thaibheoirí a bhí ann cosúil leis an bhfidléir agus cumadóir Thomas “Blind” Kiernan go dtí an saol bríomhar agus eicleáictíúil ceoil atá ann inniu, saol a thrasnaíonn na hearnálacha proifisiúnta, amaitéaracha, deonacha agus poiblí ceoil. Tá pobal láidir ealaíon sa chontae, ó ealaíontóirí cosúil le Bernard Canavan go dtí grianghrafadóirí agus dealbhóirí cáiliúla a úsáideann dair phortaigh cosúil le Michael Casey agus Brendan Colum.

Tá soláthar cultúir sa chontae seo á fhorbairt an t-am ar fad, agus tá roinnt cur chuige iontach nuálaíoch agus comhoibríoch á dtóigáil. Oibríonn an Chomhairle i gcomhpháirtíocht le grúpaí ealaíon, oidhreachta agus pobail, gnólachtaí áitiúla, daoine aonair agus an earnáil dheonach chun caighdeán na beatha níos fearr do chách a chinniú. Le tamall fada anuas, thacaigh Comhairle Contae an Longfoirt le go leor féilte, taispeántas, cóinéadachtaí, tionscadal scoile agus clár ealaíon poiblí a chothaíonn agus a choinníonn forbairt na n-ealaíon áitiúil. Déanaimid ár seacht ndícheall nasc a chothú lenár bpobail trínár seirbhís leabharlainne, agus lónra ealaíne agus oidhreachta. Léiríonn tionscnaimh cosúil le Seachtain Oidhreachta, Oíche Chultúir, Féile Ealaíne Cruthú, Féile Ealaíne Aisling do Leanaí, Féile Eolaíochta Lár na Tíre agus Féile Litríochta Mhí Dheireadh Fómhair do Leanaí na gnéithe maithe d'earnáil an chultúir agus na cruthaitheachta sa Longfort.

Music is central to the cultural identity of County Longford, from historical performers such as fiddle-player and composer Thomas “Blind” Kiernan to today's eclectic and vibrant music scene that crosses professional, amateur, voluntary and community music sectors. The county is home to a strong art community, from painters such as Bernard Canavan to photographers and famous bog-oak sculptors such as Michael Casey and Brendan Colum.

Cultural provision in this county is continually developing, with some exciting innovative and collaborative approaches being undertaken. The Council works in partnership with arts, heritage and community groups, local businesses, individuals and the voluntary sector to ensure a better quality of life for all. Longford County Council has long-supported many festivals, exhibitions, residencies, school projects and public art programmes that nurture and sustain local arts development. We endeavour to engage our communities through our library service, and arts and heritage networks. Initiatives such as Heritage Week, Bealtaine, Culture Night, the Cruthú Arts Festival, the Aisling Children's Arts Festival, the Midlands Science Festival and The October Children's Book Festival, illustrate all that is good in the creative and cultural sector in Longford.

Tarraingíonn príomháiseanna an chontae, cosúil leis an Ionad Ealaón & Amharclann Backstage, chomh maith leis an bhforbairt atá beartaithe chun Mol Cruthaitheachta agus Nuálaíochta do Sholáthróirí a thógáil agus an Leabharlann Phobail nua i Meathas Troim, aird ar ár dtiomantas d'infheistíú a dhéanamh in infreastruchtúr cultúir agus cruthaitheachta an chontae. Áirítear le haiseanna eile atá stiúrtha ag an bpobal Ionad Oidhreachta & Cruthaitheachta Ardach, an Chonair Litriochta Edgeworth, an Haggard, an Amharclann Bog Lane agus an Ionad Normannach nua ag an móta agus bábhún i nGránard. Tá an Longfort réidh tairbhe a bhaint as na deiseanna a chuireann Éire Ildánach ar fáil chun a infreastruchtúr cruthaitheachta a fhorbairt. Tá roinnt tionscnámh nua tagtha chun cinn tríd an gclár cheana féin, lena n-áirítear an Fhéile Ghearrscannán Still Voices, an Cruinníú Pádraic Colum agus an chéad fhéile eolaíochta i Meathas Troim.

Áiteanna ina dtarlaíonn 'Cultúr'

Tá cultúr faoi bhláth agus déantar é a roinnt sa Longfort sna háiteanna ina gcuinníonn daoine le chéile: amharclanna, leabharlanna, scoileanna, ionad phobail, ionad acmhainní teaghlacha, Seideanna na bhFear, clubanna, ionaid spóirt, tithe tábhairne agus féilte. Ceiliúrann an iliomad féilte atá againn oidhreacht, cultúr agus cruthaitheacht. Is gnéithe tábhachtacha de thionscal na turasóireachta sa Longfort iad agus téimid i dteaghmáil lenár nDiaspóra tríothu. Taispeánann an éagsúlacht seo beocht mhuintir an chontae agus conas a ghlaicann muintir an chontae páirt sna gnéithe difriúla a gcultúir.

The county's flagship facilities such as the Backstage Theatre & Centre for the Arts, and the planned new innovative Providers Creative and Innovation Hub and the new Edgeworthstown Community Library highlight our commitment to investing in the creative and cultural infrastructure of the county. Other community-led cultural facilities include the Ardagh Creativity & Heritage Centre, the Edgeworth Literary Trail, the Haggard, the Bog Lane Theatre and the new Granard Motte-and-Bailey Norman Centre. Longford is well-placed to avail of the opportunities presented through Creative Ireland to develop its creative infrastructure. Already, a number of new initiatives have emerged through the programme, including the Still Voices Short Film Festival, the Pádraic Colum Gathering and the first Science festival in Edgeworthstown.

Where 'Culture' happens

Culture flourishes and is shared in Longford where people gather: theatres, libraries, schools, community centres, family resource centres, Mens' Sheds, clubs, sports venues, pubs, and festivals. Our many festivals celebrate heritage, culture and creativity. They are an important component of the tourism industry in Longford and are a means of connecting with our Diaspora. This diversity demonstrates the vibrancy of and engagement the people of the county have with different aspects of their culture.

Earnáil Chultúir & Chruthaitheachta

Tá an earnáil chultúir agus chruthaitheachta sa Longfort faoi bhláth, agus tá lín na ndaoine a oibríonn i dtionscaill chruthaitheacha ag dul i méid. I measc na dtionscaill seo tá ealaíontóirí, ceoltóirí, damhsóirí, grianghraifadóirí, cleachtóirí amharclainne, ailtírí, dearthóirí grafaice, dearthóirí cluichí, lucht déanta scannán, fuaim & craoltóireacht, agus comhlachtaí meán digiteach. Oibríonn na daoine seo go maith le raon leathan daoine a chuireann eagraíochtaí proifisiúnta cultúir chun cinn, chomh maith le grúpaí pobail a egraíonn agus a ghlaicann páirt in imeachtaí, féilte, drámaíocht amaitéarach, grúpaí córúil, grúpaí scríbhneoirí, grúpaí ealaíne agus ceoil srl.

Compháirtíocht i leith Uilechuimsitheachta

Tá éiteas láidir compháirtíochta ag Comhairle Contae an Longfoirt, mar a leagtar amach inár bPlean Corparáideach, Plean Forbartha Contae agus Plean Áitiúil Eacnamaíochta agus Pobail, a dtacaíonn na Pleananna Oidhreachta, Ealaíne agus Leabharlainne leo. Tá comhoibriú idir-rannach mar bhonn faoi seo, lena n-áirítear: pobal, na healaíona, leabharlann, oidhreacht, pleannáil, spórt, timpeallacht, an Ghaeilge, turasóireacht, fiontar & infheistíocht agus ár dtí Cheantar Bardasach, Gránard, Baile Uí Mhatháin agus an Longfort.

Cultural & Creative Sector

There is a growing and thriving cultural and creative sector in County Longford, with increasing numbers working in the creative industries, including: visual artists / musicians / dancers / photographers / theatre practitioners / architects / graphic designers / game designers / film-makers / sound & broadcasting / digital media companies. They are complemented by the broad range of people who drive professional cultural organisations, and community groups who organize and participate in events, festivals, amateur drama, choral groups, writers groups, Art and music groups etc.

Partnership for Inclusion

Longford County Council has a strong partnership ethos, as set out in our Corporate Plan, County Development Plan and Local Economic Community Plan which are supported by our Library, Arts and Heritage Plans. This is underpinned by ongoing inter-departmental collaboration, including: community, arts, library, heritage, planning, sport, environment, Irish language, tourism, enterprise & investment and our three Municipal Districts Granard, Ballymahon and Longford.

Muintir & Pobal

Tá clú ar mhuintir an Longfort as a gcairdiúlacht, as an mbród atá acu ar a n-áit dúchais agus as a spiorad pobail láidir. Bhí an spiorad sin soiléir tar éis don tine uafásach a tharla ag Ardeaglais Naomh Mel i 2009. Thacaigh an pobal áitiúil agus ár nDiaspóra go ládir le hathchóiriú na hardeaglaise agus d'oscail sí arís laistigh de chuíg bliana. Tacaíonn muintir an chontae go ládir le agus glacann siad páirt in ócайдí cultúir agus tionscadail, ó imeachtaí spóirt go dtí féiléalaíne, mar a léirítear ag lón, caighdeán agus éagsúlacht na bhfeilte agus na n-imeachtaí atá réachtáil sa chontae. Chuireamar an chéad 'Longford 2017 – What's On Guide' le chéile anuraidh, eolaí a chuir os cionn 90 ócайд agus féile ar fud an chontae i láthair.

Tá an tírdhreach cultúrtha sa Longfort ag athrú agus ag forbairt go sioráí, go háirithe mar gheall ar na pobail nua atá tar éis teacht isteach ar imirce. Rinne na pobail seo an tírdhreach cultúrtha a shaibhriú agus thóg siad taithí, ceol, spórt agus scileanna nua isteach leo. Ba é ár n-ócайд deiridh den bhliaín 2017 léiriúchán speisialta de thionscadal pobail darbh ainm *'Welcoming the Stranger'*. Ghlac inimircigh ónár nIonad Soláthar Díreach agus muintir an phobail áitiúil, ag obair i gcompháirtiocht le grúpa damhsóirí agus ceoltóirí áitiúla, páirt sa léiriúchán ag an Amharclann Backstage.

Diaspora

Caomhnaíonn an Longfort naisc dhearfacha lena Dhiaspóra ar bhonn leanúnach trí Chumainn an Longfort ar fud an domhain, cleamhnais le bailte, cruinnithe teaghlaigh agus ócайдí gnó. Chuir na meáin shóisialta, chomh maith lenár suíomhanna gréasáin, an tairseach www.longford.ie san áireamh, ar ár gcumas dul i dteagmháil lenár nDiaspóra agus pobail nua

People & Community

Longford people are renowned for their warmth, pride of place and strong community spirit which was particularly evident after the devastating fire that took place in St. Mel's Cathedral in 2009, when there was a groundswell of support from the local community and our Diaspora for its restoration and reopening within five years. Support for and participation in cultural gatherings and projects from sporting events to arts festivals is very strong within the county as evidenced by the number, quality and diversity of the festivals and events running in the county. Last year we produced our first 'Longford 2017 – What's On Guide' which showcased over 90 events and festivals across the county.

The cultural landscape in Longford is continually changing and evolving, in particular through inward migration of new communities who have enriched the cultural landscape, bringing new experiences, music, sport and skills. Our closing event of 2017 was a memorable production of a community project called *'Welcoming the Stranger'* which involved immigrants from our Direct Provision Centre, members of the local community working in partnership with a group of professional dancers and musicians performing together in Backstage Theatre.

Diaspora

Longford maintains positive connections with its Diaspora on an ongoing basis, through the Longford Associations around the globe, town-twinning, clan gatherings, and business events. Social media, and our dedicated websites, including the www.longford.ie portal, has allowed us to engage with the Diaspora and new audiences around

Longford to me by John Connell Longford bestselling author of *The Cow Book*

As a farmer and writer Longford is my home. It is the place from which I draw the wellspring of my creativity. My books, my writings, my thoughts are of this place. I have known it all my life and it is the thing which enriches me.

I lived for many years as an emigrant overseas but I carried with me a piece of Longford on all those journeys. It was in the memory of family and friends, the smell of the fields round our home in Soran, Ballinalee or the thought of long summer nights of fishing by the Camlin or swimming by Lough Gowna.

Longford has been my palette as a writer and documentary maker. From its townlands, I have listened and gathered the history of this place all of which have been infused into my work. Its characters have seeped into my short stories, my fiction and my memoir. Without this county I am nothing as an artist for it has given me everything from which to draw upon.

We live in a secret county for few outsiders know of the greatness and beauty of our home. From the literary streets of Ballymahon which knew lion hunters and revered poets, to the scientific and literary endeavours of the Edgeworth family to the rebellious history of our flying column of North Longford. It was this county which was the outpost of the Elizabethan conquest and this county which was the centre piece of many bids for Irish freedom. All of these things infuse me, enrich me. I have walked the back roads of Ballinamuck in thought of the men of 1798 and they are to me as sacred as the Greek ruins for they hold in them our own native history.

Water is the great thread of our county and dotted amongst its many beautiful lakes I have seen the clear wonder of nature and God. In the summer murmurations of starlings or the mighty stride of deer in the woods of South Longford.

Longford has given so much to me as a writer but it is its people which are its greatest gift for in returning to make my home here I have seen the power, poetry and wonder of the ordinary rural people that make this county what it is: my baile and beatha.

Ceann de na príomhchuspóirí atá ag Éire Ildánach an Longfoirt is ea naisc agus lónraí a chruthú tríd an méid seo a leanas a dhéanamh:

THE MAIN FOCUS of this strategy is to expand the engagement by citizens of Longford with culture, thus fostering creativity and imagination. The aims of the strategy will dovetail with the objectives and actions articulated in the County Development Plan, the Local Economic & Community Plan and individual plans for Arts, Libraries and Heritage.

One of the key purposes of Creative Ireland Longford is to create connections and networks by:

- Adopting a more coordinated approach to highlighting the ongoing events and projects within the county
- Connecting artists, and all members of the creative community with each other and the wider community
- Disseminating information about cultural facilities and resources
- Identifying gaps in provision and a strategy for addressing these
- Creating awareness of the county's rich history and heritage and identifying ways of engaging with it, education programmes, heritage trails, walks, exhibitions and lectures, visitor centres, etc.
- Instilling a pride of place and sense of identity in our citizens, in particular our children and young people
- Creating a cultural archive through research and digitisation
- Building strong links with our Diaspora and encouraging engagement with the county
- Developing our cultural and environmental tourism products

- 1.3 A chinntíú trí chomhpháirtíocht, m.sh. an Lónra Cúraim Leanaí, agus tacaíochtaí straitéiseacha go bhfuil leanáí ábalta teacht ar dheiseanna cruthaitheacha le linn na luathbhlianta.
- 1.4 Oibriú le príomhpháirtithe leasmhara chun cumhacht agus tionchar gach tionscnamh a mhéadú.

Pillar 1: Enabling the Creative Potential of Every Child

Strategic Priority 1: Early years Creativity

A significant body of research exists in relation to the importance of creativity in early years, (0–12 years). Children who are encouraged to think creatively exhibit higher levels of motivation, tenacity, self-esteem, confidence and innovation. A key pillar of the Creative Ireland programme is that every child will have access to tuition and participation in art, music, coding and drama by 2022.

- 1.1 Increase the level of access and engagement with culture and creativity for young children through existing networks, organisations and infrastructure: schools, play schools, mother & toddler groups, parents associations, etc.
- 1.2 Prioritize the securing of the Music Generation Education Programme for County Longford.
- 1.3 Ensure, through partnership—e.g. the County Childcare Network—and strategic supports, that creative opportunities are accessible during early years.
- 1.4 Engage with key stakeholders to expand the reach and impact of all initiatives.
- 1.5 Introduce children to the joys of reading and writing for pleasure, through initiatives such as the Right to Read programme, Summer Stars, the Children's Book Festivals and creative writing clubs.

- 1.6 Straitéis cumarsáide a forbairt i gcompháirtíocht le scoileanna áitiúla agus an Plean um Scoileanna Cruthaitheacha a sheolfar go luath chun rannpháirtíocht teaghlaich i litríocht agus sna healaíona a chothú.
- 1.7 Úsáid na n-áiseanna ealaíona agus oidhreachta cultúir atá ann do scoileanna a chur chun cinn, an scéim Oidhreacht i Scoileanna agus an scéim Scríbhneoirí i Scoileanna de chuid Éigse Éireann san áireamh.

Tosaíocht Straitéiseach 2: Rannpháirtíochta Chruthaitheachta do dhéagóirí agus daoine óga.
D'fhéadfadh rannpháirtíocht i rud éigin cruthaitheach, ó na healaíona taibhiúcháin (déanamh scannán, damhsa, ceol, drámaíocht) go dtí gníomhaíochtaí níos aonaráí (scríbhneoireacht chruthaitheach, na hamharc-ealaíona, meáin nua) dul chun tairbhe déagóirí agus iad ag athrú go suntasach agus ag forbairt go pearsanta. Ceann de na gnéithe is tábhachtáil de gníomhaíocht chruthaitheach is ea go bhféadfadh sí cuidiú le féiniúlacht phearsanta a forbairt, agus ar an dóigh sin do ghuth fén, do smaointe agus mothúcháin a chur in iúl.

Tá gníomhaíocht chruthaitheach, taobh amuigh d'oideachas príomhshrutha, thar a bheith tábhachtach do dhéagóirí. Tá sé ar cheann de na bhealaí atá ar fáil dóibh spéis a chur i rudaí nua agus iad fén a léiriú ar bhealach nua, laistigh de thimpeallacht shábháilte. Is modh iad cláir ealaíon óige cumhacht a thabhairt do dhaoine óga fás agus forbairt, agus tabharfaidh siad deis dóibh scileanna nua a fhoghlaím, a bpiarghrúpa a leathnú agus muinín a forbairt. Oibreoidh lón mór daoine a ghlacann páirt i gcláir ealaíon óige sna healaíona cruthaitheacha agus tionscail cruthaitheacha agus iad níos sine.

- 1.6 Develop a communications strategy, in partnership with local schools and the soon to be launched Creative Schools Plan for engaging with families on literacy and the arts.
- 1.7 Promote the use of existing cultural heritage and arts amenities for schools, including the Heritage in Schools Scheme and Poetry Ireland Writers in Schools.

Strategic Priority 2: Creative engagement for teenagers and young people.

Being involved in something creative, from performing arts (film-making, dance, music, drama) to more solitary activities (creative writing, visual arts, new media) can benefit teenagers at a time of enormous change and personal development. One of the most important aspects of creative activity is that it can help to develop a sense of personal identity: expressing one's own voice, thoughts and feelings.

Creative activity, outside of mainstream education, is particularly important for teenagers. It is one of the ways they can develop new interests, experiences and self-expression in a safe environment. Youth arts programmes are a means of empowering young people to grow and develop, and will allow them to learn new skills, expand their peer group and gain confidence. Many who engage with youth arts programmes go on to work professionally in the creative arts and creative industries.

- 2.4 Oibriú i gcomhar leis an mBord Oideachais agus Oiliúna an Longfoirt agus na hIarmhí chun a chinntíú go ndéanfar an clár Ghlúin an Cheoil, a bheidh á leathnú ar fud na tíre, a leathadh amach in imeachtaí na gceithre bliana atá romhainn.

Strategic Objectives:

- 2.1 Encourage better access to resources and expertise through strategic engagement with organisations, such as Comhairle na nÓg, Foróige, Longford Youth Services, Schools Completion Officer and existing arts infrastructure and organisations including Backstage Youth Theatre, Longford School of Rock and the Attic Youth Café.
- 2.2 Where possible extend access to creative engagement of all kinds outside of school at community and local level through libraries, sports, cultural and community venues.
- 2.3 Support existing resources such as Backstage Youth Theatre, Longford School of Rock, Comhaltas Ceoltóirí Éireann.
- 2.4 Work in partnership with Longford-Westmeath Education & Training Board to ensure the Music Generation programme, which is to be extended nationwide, is rolled out in this county over the next four years.

Pillar 2: Enabling Creativity in Every Community

The empowerment of local authorities to lead the engagement of our citizens with arts and culture is a key part of the plan.

Strategic Priority 3: Promote local libraries, arts centres, family resource centres, clubs, schools and community centres as key cultural and creativity hubs. Identify gaps in provision and undertake a cultural mapping audit.

Beidh cumarsáid agus comhordú eolais faoi na hearnálacha cultúir agus cruthaitheachta ina chuid thábhachtach d'obair Fhoireann Éire Ildánach an Longfort ar thréimhse na straitéis seo. Maidir le rath agus inbhuanaitheachta na n-earnálacha seo, beidh sé rithábhachtach feasacht a chruthú agus lucht spéise d'imeachtaí, tionscadail agus cláir a mhéadú. Tá clú náisiúnta agus idirnáisiúnta bainte amach ag ár scríbhneoirí, ealaíontóirí, ceoltóirí, damhsóirí, srl. agus tá sé tábhachtach go gcuirfimid a gcuid oibre chun cinn agus go dtuaispeáin faimid a gcuid oibre. Tá sé mar aidhm ag an straitéis seo mol bríomhar tábhachtach i Lár na Tíre a dhéanamh den Longfort.

Tugtar treoir do Chomhairle Contae an Longfort ag prionsabail na huilechuiumsitheachta sóisialta agus le linn na bliana 2017 d'éirigh leis an gComhairle comhroinnt acmhainní idir ionaid, agus pobail, agus trasna earnálacha agus disciplíní a spreagadh. Áirítear leis na samplai thar barr:

- Lá na Samhláiochta Pushkin do bhunscoileanna i gcompháirtíocht leis an Ionad Oideachais Chora Droma Rúisc agus an Iontaobhas Pushkin.
- Tionscadal feasachta ar ghabhlán ghaoithe: compháirtíocht idir saorálaithe áitiúla, Oifig Oidhreachta an Longfort, Oifig Timpeallachta an Longfort, Caomhantas Gabhlán Gaoithe Éireann agus pobail agus eagraíochtaí áitiúla.
- Fáilte a chur roimh an Strainséir: tionscadal damhsa a fhraigheann inspioráid ó scéalta imirceach agus dídeanaithe, i gcompháirtíocht leis an Amharclann Backstage.

Trí leanúint de chompháirtíochaí straitéiseacha a bheith againn, agus trí chláreagrú (idir chultúrtha agus thíreolaíoch) d'áiseanna cultúir agus oidhreachta, éascóidh Éire Ildánach an Longfort comhoibriú agus piarthacaíocht níos mó do ghrúpaí ealáiona agus ceoil, rud ar tarraingíodh aird air san aiseolas a fuarthas le linn an phróisis chomhairliúcháin.

The communication and coordination of information about the cultural and creative sectors will be a major part of the work of the Creative Ireland Longford Team over the period of this strategy. Creating awareness and building audiences for events, projects and programmes will be critical to their success and sustainability. Our writers, artists, actors, musicians, dancers, etc. have achieved national and international fame and it is important that we promote and showcase their work. The aim of the strategy is to make Longford a vibrant creative hub in the Midlands.

Longford County Council is guided by the principles of social inclusion and throughout 2017 they have successfully incentivised the sharing of resources between venues, and communities, and across sectors and disciplines. Some excellent examples include:

- The Pushkin Day of the Imagination for primary schools in partnership with Carrick on Shannon Education centre and the Pushkin trust.
- Swift Awareness Project: a partnership between local volunteers, Longford Heritage Office, Longford Environment Office, Swift Conservation Ireland and local communities and organisations.
- Welcoming the Stranger: a dance project inspired by the stories of migrants and refugees in partnership with Backstage Theatre.

Through continuing strategic partnerships, and programming (both artistic and geographic) for culture and heritage facilities, Creative Ireland Longford will facilitate greater cooperation and peer support for artists and art and music groups which was highlighted in the feedback from the Consultation process.

Leagann an tosaíocht seo béis láidir ar dheiseanna a chur ar fáil chun cruthaitheacht a chur os comhair an phobail, a cheiliúradh agus a fheiceáil. Áiritear leis seo grúpaí ceardaíochta, drámaíocht amaitéarach, cóir phobail, grúpaí oidhreachta áitiúla, agus grúpaí scríbhneoreachta.

Strategic Objectives:

- 3.1 Provide information to communities about the existing resources available for sharing creativity.
- 3.2 Continue to promote a Creative Ireland annual grants scheme.
- 3.3 Undertake a Longford cultural mapping process.
- 3.4 Through existing infrastructure, continue to promote residency/workshop programmes, tailored to local demand (in heritage/film-making/creative writing/music/visual art/drama/dance/traditional arts/coding/robotics/craft, etc).
- 3.5 Continue to coordinate and produce a "Whats on Guide" to all cultural events/programmes in the county.
- 3.6 Ensure all Creative Ireland supported projects and initiatives are inclusive of the whole community including new citizens.
- 3.7 Through existing infrastructure, support expanded provision for hard to reach communities.

Strategic Priority 4: Promote democratisation of culture through heritage, arts and cultural organisations working with communities

This priority has a strong emphasis on the provision of opportunities to show-case, celebrate and experience community-lead creativity. It includes craft groups, amateur drama, community choirs, local heritage groups, and writing groups.

Strategic Objectives:

- 4.1 Encourage the provision of space and opportunities for local arts and heritage groups to show-case their work through local libraries and festivals.
- 4.2 Encourage sharing of knowledge and skills between local arts, crafts and heritage groups, including visiting experts and specialists.
- 4.3 Encourage skills-sharing including traditional skills in communities and between generations using festivals like Bealtaine and Heritage Week and through networks like Longford Age Friendly Council.
- 4.4 Continue to ensure that key target groups are provided for within Longford, including people with disabilities, older people, intercultural groups and marginalized groups through existing networks such as Longford Intercultural Working Group, Longford Traveller Movement and Longford Women's Link.
- 4.5 Include local communities and the voluntary sector in specific developmental initiatives, e.g. the new Edgeworthstown Community Library and the Providers Creative and Innovation Hub.
- 4.6 Organize a Blian na Gaeilge programme promoting Irish language and culture in partnership with relevant national cultural institutions.
- 4.7 Promote the Decade of Commemorations with a focus on important local events and people.

- 4.8 Bliain Eorpach na hOidhreachta Cultúr agus ár gcomóradh céad bliain ar cheart vótála na mban a cheiliúradh i 2018.
- 4.9 Dul i dteaghmháil le Diaspóra an Longfoirt atá ar fud an domhain ar bhealaí nuálaíocha trínár n-acmhainní cultúir agus oidhreachta. D'fhéadfadh cuid mhór de na hábhair a bhaineann le stair an Longfoirt, nach féidir rochtain a fháil orthu ach i Rannóg na Cartlainne agus Staidéar Áitiúil de chuid Leabharlann an Longfoirt agus i nuachtáin aítiúla, grianghraif, léarscáileanna, leabhair mhiontuairisci, dialanna agus litreacha, a dhigitiú agus a chur ar fáil ar www.longford.ie. Tá rún againn leanúint de www.longfordatwar.ie a fhorbairt.

- 4.8 Celebrate European year of Cultural Heritage and our Centenary of Women's Suffrage in 2018.
- 4.9 Reach out to the worldwide Longford Diaspora in innovative ways through our cultural and heritage resources. Many of the treasure of Longford's history and past are currently only accessible in the Longford Library Local Studies and Archives Department and local newspapers, photographs, maps, minute books, diaries and letters could be digitised and made available through www.longford.ie. We also intend to continue to develop www.longfordatwar.ie.

Strategic Priority 5: Value and support our artists, craftspeople and the Longford creative community.

Artists, craftspeople, designers, writers, filmmakers, musicians and other creative people who live and work here and showcase a very positive image of Longford to the world need to be valued and encouraged to continue living here. They underpin the creative economy within the county and in addition to their own practice, they work in schools, in care settings and with diverse communities, sharing their skills and expertise. They provide wonderful exhibitions, beautiful recitals, inspiring readings, transformative ideas and add colour, imagination and vitality to the life of the county.

Strategic Objectives:

- 5.1 Through existing infrastructure provide opportunities for creative people to meet, network, skill-share and support each other.
- 5.2 In partnership with the Local Enterprise Office and other key agencies provide spaces and opportunities for them to show-case their work in Longford and at prestigious national events.
- 5.3 Communicate the value of our artists by connecting them to local communities and by offering them opportunities to work through the Creative Ireland Programme.
- 5.4 Promote the cultural, creative and heritage sectors on the internet, on social media as well as using all the platforms that will become available through Creative Ireland nationally.
- 5.5 Develop a database of Longford artists, and creative people of all disciplines, to promote the growing number of artists in the county and provide a platform for them to share their information/portfolios, etc.

Strategic Priority 6: Develop creativity in Longford, encouraging participation, innovation and problem solving, with a strong focus on our young people
In a county with a thriving creative community, where heritage is respected and celebrated, there are huge opportunities for developing the creative sector. The creation of spaces for inter-disciplinary co-operation between artists, tourism and heritage sectors and broader industry will lead to enhanced Creative and Cultural Industries (CCIs) and strengthen cultural tourism in the county. There are already initiatives which place creativity at the heart of developing resourceful and entrepreneurial skills to equip young people to deal flexibly with future economic challenges e.g. Longford Young

Entrepreneurs programme and Young Scientist competition.

It is generally acknowledged that quality art and cultural education has the potential to improve concentration, divergent thinking, non-verbal thinking, interest in exploration, imagination and originality in learners. The aim of this strategic priority will be to maximise these skills in Longford.

Strategic Objectives:

- 6.1 Augment Longford's identity as a creative county by developing spaces for children and families to explore their creativity in enjoyable and engaging ways, e.g. Providers Creative and Innovation Hub, Edgeworthstown Digital Hub, Granard Motte and Bailey Norman Centre and Ardagh Creativity & Heritage Centre.
- 6.2 Promote innovation, new ideas and the celebration of individual and collective creativity.
- 6.3 Support and grow existing provision such as Science week, Heritage Week, Cranniú and Culture Night.

- 6.4 Deiseanna a chur ar fáil do dhaointe óga smaointe a chumadh, agus smaointeoireacht chruthaitheach agus réiteach fadhbanna a dhéanamh trí cheardlanna arna n-eagrú i gcompháirtíocht leis an gclár Fionraithe Óga.

- 6.5** Promote the use of creative consultation for relevant communities, in relation to public spaces.
- 6.6** Work with other counties in the region to explore opportunities for collaboration e.g. Music Generation, the shared vision for Lough Ree and the Mid-Shannon region, the Midlands Arts and Culture magazine, Blueway and Greenway initiatives and maximise investment in creativity.

- We have created a mailing list specific to community organisations and individuals who are engaged with the Creative Ireland Programme in County Longford.
- We have developed a strong social media presence on Facebook, Twitter and Instagram. The core of this is our Facebook page (www.facebook.com/creativeirelandlongford) and Twitter Account (@CreativeLongfd), and we are building audiences across all three platforms. We are also utilising the Longford Library Vimeo, YouTube and Flickr accounts. We will explore emerging platforms as they come on-stream. Creative Longford is also being cross-promoted through Longford County Council (www.longfordcoco.ie) and Longford Library (www.longfordlibrary.ie), and Longford tourism and business websites.

Organization of work programme

- Delegation of duties for specific programmes within the Plan to be agreed among the Culture Team members.
- The Grant scheme, which was run successfully last year with over 50 projects benefitting from it, is to be streamlined in line with the strategic objectives in the Plan. Funding of projects to be agreed by Creative Ireland Culture Team.
- Grant Scheme will be announced in January of each year.

- All Creative Ireland run events and all documentation generated must be branded with Longford County Council and Creative Ireland Longford brands.
- A What's on Guide to the County will be produced in partnership with Longford Tourism.

Follow-up and Evaluation

- Culture team members will attend and engage with as many Creative Ireland supported initiatives / projects as possible.
- Project organisers will update the Culture team on the progress of their projects and programmes.
- All social media promotion by organizers will be shared with Creative Ireland.
