

How do we decide if our project meets the criteria required to apply?

In general, for projects to meet our application criteria they need to link with a health policy, and please see p.6 of the Grant Call pdf for the non-exhaustive guiding list. It is important to clearly link and articulate the link to your chosen policy/plan/strategy in your application.

Also, on p.9 of our Grant Call pdf, in the Policy Context section of our grant call, project applications will be assessed as to how to they contribute to at least one of the health-related bulleted list of aims beginning 'Contribute to at least one of the following: • the core determinants of health... etc'. I would advise being explicit in which bullet/ bullet points your project aims to address in the application.

In deciding whether or not to apply for our call, the main considerations for you should be how well you meet the above requirements and how strongly you can demonstrate that your project will further the aims of the grant call.

We cannot guarantee any project will be successful, as that will depend on the completion of a full application including the relevant senior HSE manager letter of support, and also the overall competitive process.
